Dr Saman Gamage received his M.Phil. in Habitat Ecology and Ph.D. in Taxonomy Ecology. He re-discovered montane loris after 76 years and photographed it for the very first time. His Ph.D. Thesis was on "Revision of taxonomy, distribution, abundance and habitat preference the slender loris in Sri Lanka". The study concludes that there are at least three Loris species with several new subspecies present in Sri Lanka. Currently he is conducting a project to conserve the highland loris in montane forest areas.
